



The Catholic Schools of the Archdiocese are supported by all Catholics, and by the parents of those children of other religions who attend them as space permits. Therefore, it has been and remains, the policy of the Archdiocese to follow a pattern of open admission. Thus, all schools are open first to Catholic children within a parish, then to Catholic children outside the parish and then to all other children.

Considering the above, the policy for priority of acceptance is as follows:

- Brothers and sisters of those already in St. Jane Frances School
- Registered, practicing and contributing parishioners of St. Jane Frances Church
- Non-registered parishioners
- Non-parishioners

St. Jane Frances School in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, mindful of its mission to be a witness to the love of Christ for all, welcomes students of all race, color, national, ethnic, and religious origins to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students in this school.

Early Submission dates: January 1, 2025 through January 31, 2025

General Submission: February 1, 2025 through March 15, 2025

Late Submission (automatic waitlist): March 16, 2025 through May 1, 2025

Preschool, TK & Kindergarten Assessment Dates: February 7, March 7, March 21

Students entering Grades 1-7 must attend a ½ day shadow day (8am-11am or 11am-2pm) during the 2024-25 school year to be considered for admission.

For entrance to Preschool, students must be 3 years of age on or before September 1 and must be fully potty trained. The recommended age for transitional kindergarten (TK) students is four years of age on or before September 1. The recommended age for kindergarten students is five years of age on or before September 1. The recommended age for first grade students is six years of age on or before September 1. All students must comply with current California immunization and health requirements prior to enrollment.



Tuition Schedule 2025-2026

Grades Preschool through 8th Grade

Fees*:

Registration: \$500 for first child & \$200/each for additional children in the family. (School fees cover textbook rental, workbooks, testing, student accident insurance, emergency supplies, and in-class technology upgrades). \$100/child deposit due immediately via [FACTS.com](https://facts.com) to re-register.

Registration must be paid in full by July 15, 2025.

Tuition Rate: \$5900 per year. Siblings receive a \$2500 discount per year.

Catholic Discounted Rate: \$500 discount per child

One child	\$5,400
Two children	\$8,300
Three children	\$11,200

- Please submit proof of parish enrollment such as a Sunday envelope or online enrollment to receive the discounted rate.

Fundraising:

Option A: There is a minimum of \$700 in mandatory fundraising over the course of the school year. This may be raised via the Jog-a-Thon, Chocolate Sale, Raffle tickets, or any other fundraising opportunity provided by the principal. If not paid by June 1, 2026, the remaining balance will be charged to the family via [FACTS.com](https://facts.com)

Option B: Cash donation to the school of \$550 (This is tax-deductible) payable by June 1, 2026. This may be added to your tuition in a monthly payment of \$55.

Service Hours:

15 Hours required per family.

Any hours remaining after June 1, 2026 will be charged \$30 per hour via [FACTS.com](https://facts.com)

Important Notes:

If tuition is paid to the school office **BEFORE** September 15, 2025, it is eligible for a 5% discount. Please see the school office for details.

Tuition Payments are due either on the 10th or 20th of each month via [FACTS.com](https://facts.com). A late fee of \$35 will be charged if it is not received within 5 days of the due date.

Financial aid is available through the Catholic Education Foundation. Please see the office for the application procedures. You must apply for financial aid every year.
