### General Supplies and Materials:

6 COMPOSITION notebooks- college-ruled, 7 7/8 x 10  
No spiral notebooks. Notebooks are strictly required to be COMPOSITION NOTEBOOKS, pictured to the left. We have tried in the past to use other forms of notebooks. They have fallen apart easily throughout the year and have caused disorganization and lost material. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

- 3 Reams of Copy Paper (500 sheets)
- 3 packages College-Ruled Loose Leaf (8.5 x 11)
- 1 package Quadrille Ruled paper (8.5 x 11)
- 1 package of #2 pencils (8 count)
- 1 package blue or black pens (10 count)
- 1 green pen
- Highlighter
- 1 pack ruled index cards (3x5, 100 count)
- Small pencil case to hold materials
- 2 Two-pocket folders
- 2 folders with prongs (pictured to the right)
